




Dear Parishioners,

"Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You." (Diary, 47)

"I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over [its] enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I myself will defend it as my own glory." (Diary,47-48)

"The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the water that makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls ...These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when my agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross." (Diary, 299).



rishioners for their donations and financial support to "feed the needy" (a quote from Pope Francis).



Rev. Walter Dziordz

I have been the Pastor of Our Lady of Peace Parish since 2006. I am a member of the Marians of the Immaculate Conception. I had been the Provincial Superior for thirteen years and also a Pastor in Greensboro, North Carolina. I am originally from Massachusetts. In addition to the above, I served in the U.S. Army for three years, with one additional year in the National Guard. I hold M.Div and D.Min degrees.

Nancy Nuzbach

I have been a parishioner of Our Lady of Peace for over forty years. During this time, I have taken part in several activities, including Parish Council, School Board, REO, volunteering at school, while three daughters attended, and assisting at mass as a Eucharistic Minister.

I have a BSEd in regular and special education as well as masters degrees in special ed and educational administration. I taught special ed as a self contained classroom teacher and as an Inclusion Facilitator in public schools. During the last twelve years of teaching, I also served as assistant to the principal, leading three principal selection committees and assuming his/her responsibilities in their absence. Retired now, I still return to my school to substitute and stay current with teaching strategies and educational issues. I have been a parishioner of Our Lady of Peace for twenty seven years. During this time my three children graduated from the school. I currently am the chairman of the finance council and counting ministry. I attended St. John Fisher of Chicago for grammar school, Brother Rice High School of Chicago and St. Mary's college of Minnesota. My professional background was a partner with Accenture and CIO of Peoples Energy Company.

Kim Rucinski

I have been part of the wonderful Our Lady of Peace School family for the past four years. I graduated from Marquette University with a degree in Elementary Education and a minor in Interdisciplinary Social Sciences. I obtained my Masters in School Counseling from Concordia University. At Kolb School in Oak Lawn I was part of the Guiding Coalition Team, assisted in district wide curriculum studies, faculty supervisor of the service club and mentored several student teachers. I have taught graduate level courses at Concordia University and worked in their on campus counseling center. In the past four years at Our Lady of Peace School I have been co-chair of the annual auction and gala, room parent coordinator, a room parent, co-chair of the mother/ son events, co-chair of the father/son events, and the education school board member.

Kellie Moore

I have worked for Our Lady of Peace for thirty years as the parish-school business manager. The first twenty years were under the leadership of former Pastor Fr. Alphonse Micka and the last ten under Fr. Walter Dziordz. My office oversees the day to day financial and facility operations of the campus in coordination with the Pastor, staff members and all council leaders. I plan and organize the staff to help the parish achieve goals set by the Pastor and his councils. When appropriate, I closely with the Diocese of Joliet finance office on special projects or planning. Previously, I have participated in three Catholic school principal search committees. My two daughters are alumni of our school and I volunteered in the athletic department as a coach and a Girl Scout leader.

Mrs. Karen Udell serves as the Our Lady of Peace Principal Search Committee Facilitator. Karen spent 38 years in area public school systems as both a teacher and administrator. She served for 23 years in Valley View School District 365-U, ten years in Troy 30-C, and 5 years in Orland 135, a district from which she retired on June 30, 2008, as *Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment*. On July 1 of the same year, Karen accepted the position of Principal of St. Raphael Catholic School in Naperville, Illinois. In November of 2012, Mrs. Udell was named *Assistant Superintendent of Leadership and Personnel* for the Diocese of Joliet Catholic Schools Office.

In this role, Karen is responsible for recruiting, screening, and interviewing teachers and administrators for all Catholic elementary schools in the Diocese of Joliet. The OLOP search is the 38th Principal Search for which Karen has been responsible over the past six years. She is passionate about Catholic Education and is an advocate for both teachers and school leaders.


Nicole Serpico-Ward


